HOW TO REGISTER

Class sizes are limited, you may join the waitlist if the class is full.

- 1. Starting Monday, December 4th at 8pm, go to https://www.homeroom.com/sites/cragmont-elementary-berkeley
- 2. Click on the <u>sign up</u> button at the top right hand corner and choose parent
- 3. Choose an email and password and hit register
- 4. Once inside your portal click the family tab and then add each child you would like to register.
- 5. Add to cart the class that you would like to enroll your child in: *Your cart will be held for 25 minutes after that, it will expire
- 6. Submit payment via credit card
 - *If you prefer to pay with a check, please fill out a paper application and make checks payable to Cramont PTA and include your student's name, then drop it off at Cragmont's main office.
 - Please note: Your child will not be enrolled until payment is received.
- 7. Await confirmation email from Homeroom, and add chosen classes to your personal calendar!

<u>Please register by Wednesday, December 13 at 10pm</u> (classes with openings may accept late registrations). If the class is full, sign up for the waiting list as spots may open up. Please do not send your child to the class if they are waitlisted until you receive a confirmation email.

If you do not have access to a computer, you may obtain paper registration forms in the main office and submit a payment using a check. Please drop paper forms in the PTA mailbox in the main office as soon as possible.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

Behavior policies apply for all classes. BUSD and Cragmont behavior policies apply for all afterschool enrichment classes. Students may be excused from a class, for the day or the remainder of the term without a refund. Students are expected to respect the feelings, rights, and property of others, and not disrupt the class.

Check In & Check Out Policy:

Students are not allowed on the school grounds without adult supervision, either before or after the PTA classes. Remind your child which classes they are signed up for and check in with them regularly.

Before class:

TK&K:

kids will be picked up outside the kinder yard each day by Ms. Annette. She will check them in, and deliver to the correct enrichment instructor daily.

For Grades 1st-5th:

- LEARNS: students first check in with LEARNS <u>no later than 5</u> <u>min. after release time</u>. After check in, they should walk to room 106 patio and check in with Ms. Annette.
- -Non-LEARNS: students should report directly to Room 106 with Ms. Annette promptly after school.

After class:

- -Non LEARNS: Pick up with Ms. Annette in Room 106. Please pick up your non-LEARNS student on time at the end of class (Late pick up fee of \$25 applied after the first 5 late minutes.)
- -LEARNS: Students will be delivered to LEARNS staff. Parent pick up with LEARNS staff during your normal pick up time.

HOW TO CANCEL

You may receive a prorated refund—minus 6% processing fees—after 2 weeks (you may attend 2 classes for those that meet weekly). Requests for cancellation must be received <u>before</u> the 3rd week of class. There are no refunds offered after attending for 3 or more weeks, for any reason. Behavioral policies apply.*
